

## PRIVACY NOTICE

In order for you to attend Emirates Stadium (“**Stadium**”), it is necessary for The Arsenal Football Club Plc (“**Club**”) to collect and process personal data from you, including health data such as test results.

Failure to provide this data will mean that you will not be allowed access to the Stadium. The Club will process your data as a data controller in accordance with applicable data protection laws and its data privacy policies and procedures.

Depending on your relationship with the Club, the lawful basis of this processing is that it is necessary for: (i) the performance of your employment or services contract with the Club; and/or (ii) the Club’s compliance with its legal obligations and/or legitimate interests in operating the Stadium in a safe and lawful manner.

The Club will not share your personal data with any third parties (unless required to do so or if the Club considers it necessary to assist with the purpose for which it is collected), and your personal data will be used for as long as it is necessary but will be deleted once it is no longer required by the Club (which in the case of health data will be no more than 30 days following the date on which it is provided), unless otherwise communicated to you by the Club and/or required by law.

It is not necessary for you to provide your consent to this use of your personal data but you do have legal rights in relation to it.
