EMIRATES STADIUM ACCESS

Media accreditation can be collected from the media entrance at Emirates Stadium, next to The Armoury Store on Hornsey Road. The media entrance opens 3 hours prior to kick-off.

- ID must be shown on entry, in order to gain access and collect media accreditation
- Please limit the nu,ber of personal items you bring to the Stadium to minimise queueing times and searching
- Please ensure you remain in the working zones to which you have been accredited
- Unfortunately, we cannot offer parking at Emirates Stadium





MEDIA LOUNGE & PHOTOGRAPHERS' WORKROOM

- You will be guided to our Media Lounge on arrival where we will be serving hot food and drinks for you to enjoy.
- Our Photographers' Workroom, which is location in the south-west corner of the stadium (please ask on arrival for directions), will also be serving hot food and drinks.



PRESS BOX

- You will be assigned a seat in our Press Box / Media Lounge. This will also be displayed on your Matchday Media Accreditation.
- Please sit in your allocated position.



POST-MATCH MEDIA MEDIA CONFERENCES

- Post-match media conferences are open and operate as in-person events for media to attend.
- Access to post-match media conferences will be available in-person only.



MIXEDZONE

Our post-match Mixed Zone will be operation. A member of the Communications team will be positioned outside of the Press Conference Room at the end of the match to allocate access wristbands to a representation of media attending.

MEADOWPARK ACCESS

- Access will be open two hours before kickoff
- Access for all accredited personnel is via the north entrance – please bring ID in order to gain entry
- Please ensure you remain in the working zones to which you have been accredited
- Unfortunately, we cannot offer reserved car parking at Meadow Park, but the pay-anddisplay Brook Road car park may be used (no charge on Sundays)





MEDIA ROOM & PRESS BOX

- The media room is located in the east stand (closest end to the North Bank)
- Snack bags and programmes will be provided for all accreditees on arrival at the south entrance
- The Press Box is located in the centre of the West Stand
- We're pleased to confirm that the Press Box has been expanded and additional power supply has been installed
- A seating plan will be provided to facilitate use of this area. Please sit in your assigned seat





POST-MATCHMEDIA ACCESS

- Post-match media with players and coaches will run as in-person "huddles" for all accredited media
- Post-match media will take place in the Media Access area – between the scoreboard and the dressing rooms (please access via the gate at the south end of Meadow Park)
- A member of the Communications team will be located in the Press Box during the game.


